EXPOSED AGGREGATE SELECTION

Exposed aggregate concrete is created when a mix of gravel or other crushed material is added to your concrete. The exposed decorative look is then created when the contractor removes surface fines from the concrete with a special treatment. This process results in the internal aggregate being exposed highlighting the natural elements of the stone.

NOTE: The exposed aggregate shown is indicative only. The final result on site also varies by what aggregates are available at the concrete plant and suppliers near your area. Stone after all is a natural product and its look may vary depending on what rock is being quarried at any given point in time.
